We are looking for local artists with experience in murals/street art to help us transform our new office space into a vibrant creative hub, to inspire positive vibes and reflect the nature of the creative organisations and young people that will be sharing the space.

About the Project

Portsmouth Creates supports the creative and cultural sectors by providing opportunities and platforms for artists and organisations across Portsmouth. We've recently moved into a new building with the ambition of sharing the space with several creative organisations. The downstairs space will be a vibrant creative hub run by young people with support from Artswork, while the upper offices are being prepared for creative businesses to move in.

We feel this a perfect project to provide opportunities for local creatives and we're looking for artists to help us create a fresh, innovative look that reflects the vibrant and welcoming atmosphere of creative Portsmouth. Our goal is to create a unique and creative work environment that inspires collaboration and positive vibes and who better to work with than local artists to achieve this?

Creative Brief

We fully encourage you to take creative freedom with this project and do what you do best. We trust your vision and invite you to explore your own ideas, concepts, and interpretations. Your creativity is key to transforming our space into a dynamic, inspiring environment.

Design Goals

• **Professional yet playful:** The artwork should feel appropriate for a workplace while inspiring creativity.

- **Inviting and accessible atmosphere:** Ensure the space feels welcoming for both employees and visitors.
- Celebrate creativity: Interpret in your own unique way.

The Spaces

- **Entrance stairs and landing:** This is the first impression visitors will have, so make it eye-catching and welcoming. We're open to bold designs and fun elements that flow up the stairs.
- **Open-Plan Reception Area:** A communal area that links the landing area and long corridor to offices.

• **Long Corridor:** Create a cohesive look that flows along the corridor, and connects the various office spaces.

Style and Feel

- **Colour Choices:** There are no restrictions on materials or colours. Feel free to explore different textures, finishes, and palettes to enhance the overall atmosphere.
- **Murals and Artwork:** Eye-catching designs that reflect creativity, community, and/or Portsmouth's heritage are encouraged.

 - i. (we are not asking for full design proposals to be submitted, a description of your ideas alongside examples of your previous work will suffice)
- 4. A description of how your creative idea fits within the space/area
- 5. The budget required to complete your work How long you think it will take to complete A separate budget line for materials

(N.B. We are currently in the process of securing a discount with a local paint supplier for you to purchase materials directly and will update you accordingly.)
